尽 VOTER TURNOUT

Voter representation is central to ensure a neighborhood has the power to initiate change. Through the direct voter education and encouragement efforts of the No Boundaries Coalition voter turnout doubled between 2014 and 2018 in the neighborhoods we serve. By hosting parties at the polls, providing rides to early voting, and ensuring our community events were centered on encouraging voter turnout we inspired people to engage civically and understand the inherent value of their vote.

♠ YOUTH PROGRAM

Baltimore City youth are our future. It's critical we invest resources in their development. No Boundaries hinges on neighbors being informed of our efforts. Connecting our neighbors to our initiatives means that we must go to them directly. It's not enough to share information through traditional channels like social media, email, or flyers distributed in the neighborhood.

To address this challenge we hired 20 youth organizers to assist with our outreach efforts in the community. Youth designed outreach initiatives based on issues they cared about. They hosted a youth assembly with over 80 participants and participated in two service projects that furthered their understanding of the challenges and opportunities in the neighborhoods we serve. With our assistance, three youth leaders participated in a community organizing training in New Orleans.

If we want our neighborhoods to thrive, it is critical we invest in Baltimore youth and provide them with the skills to build a better Baltimore.



≫ FRESH AT THE AVENUE

With 8 out of the top 15 top causes of death in 21217 being food caused or mitigate, availability for fresh food is often taken for granted. 85% of residents in our community live in healthy food priority areas, experiencing food apartheid-a hyper-saturation of destructive foods and predatory marketing, and a blatantly discriminatory corporate controlled food system that results in our communities suffering, according to the National Black Food and Justice Alliance. Fresh at the Avenue is about restoring the injustice that occurs when families lack access to high quality, affordable and culturally relevant food. We are creating a place where residents are given the dignity of food choice in a setting that reflects the value of the people served regardless of income level.








OUR GROWTH

This year No Boundaries achieved a significant financial milestone and generated over half a million dollars in revenue. This marks a 13% growth in revenue over the previous fiscal year. In 2019, No Boundaries maintained its track record of responsible growth and financial stability. New revenue will support the continued growth of our programs, increasing the number of neighbors we can serve in a year, and adding capacity that allows us to achieve greater impact for our advocacy initiatives.
